RSU ISA Development goals 2018

1. A well-developed and functional association to represent students

1.1. RSU ISA is a democratically elected organization.

Indicators:

- 1. 15% of all international RSU students participate in ISA election;*
- 2. Latvian students are involved in electing the board;*
- 3. Every student is given the possibility to vote through online voting*
- 4. Live stream of election is provided*

1.2. The new board is properly introduced to their tasks through a handover seminar

Indicator:

- 1. Planned and executed by previous board members*
- 2. Takes place within 2 months after the election*

1.3. Positions that cover the whole spectrum of students' interests

Indicator:

- 1. Head of Sports is appointed*
- 2. In case of vacant positions, they will be filled within 2 months*

1.4. A board meeting is held every month of the academic year

Indicator: Yes/No

1.5. There is a functional and organized activist group

Indicators:

- 1. 1 project planned and organized solely by activists per year*
- 2. 15 activists partaking in creating different events throughout the year*

1.6. There is an ISA Newsletter that informs students about their academic, social, and scientific interests and events, organised by student associations: ISA, SP and societies

Indicator:

- 1. Sent to all subscribed students' emails in the first week of every month of the academic calendar:*
- 2. 100 new subscribers each semester*

1.7. ISA and SP events and posters are uploaded bilingually (Latvian and English) on social media

1.8. Uploaded ISA events on RSU calendar

1.9. A budget for Scientific societies will be provided

2. RSU Students' academic interests are met

2.1. Medical curriculum is reevaluated for certain clinical and preclinical subjects.

2.2. Reevaluated criteria for Academic Scholarships.

Indicator: Find ideas from Medical and Dentistry students by holding open meeting

2.3. A scientific event will be held on a monthly basis

2.4. 3 radiology workshops by the end of the tenure of the board

2.5. A successful International Medical Symposium is organized

- 1. Over 100 participants;*
- 2. 80% of participants evaluate it as a 4 out of 5, or higher, on surveys;*
- 3. It includes more than 2 workshops and guest lectures*

2.6. The connection between ISA and the Faculty of Dentistry is improved

Indicators:

- 1. An association representing international Dentistry students is activated and has democratic elections each year;*
- 2. 1 meeting with the semester leaders of Dentistry each semester;*

2.7. The possibility and benefits of mixed groups for Dentistry students are explored

Indicator: Find out the opinion of dentistry students and academic staff on mixed groups

2.8. Interest groups are widely open for International Students

Indicators:

- 1. 3 meetings per year of the Latvian interest groups are held in English;*
- 2. 2 new fully English Interest groups are created;*
- 3. Information about the Interest group meetings are available bilingually (Latvian and English) and promoted by ISA*

3. RSU Students' non-academic interests are met

3.1. At least 1 event is organized together with Latvian students during the Orientation Week

Indicator: Yes/No

3.2. Increased possibilities of sports activities

Indicators:

- 1. A Head of Sports has been appointed;*
- 2. At least 2 sport event per semester;*
- 3. Promote current sports events*

4. *Taurenis has at least 3 international teams attending*

3.3. Social events are offered to students

Indicator:

1. *There are new social events: theatre play, ISA Anniversary, Halloween party, Anamnesis workshop*

2. *Existing events are maintained*

2. *80% of participants evaluate it as a 4 out of 5, or higher, on surveys*
